# By the Proprietaries.

WHEREAS *John Peter Sauringer* of the County of *Lancaster* hath requested that we would grant *him* to take up *Five Hundred* Acres of Land *situate in Hopewell Township in Conococheague Adjoining*



*Peter Hervey* of the County of *Lancaster* for which *he* agrees to pay to our Use *the Sum of* in the Fifteen Pounds Ten Shillings current Money of this Province for *every* *—* Hundred Acres, and the yearly Quit-rent of one Half-penny Sterling for every Acre thereof; THESE are therefore to authorize and require thee to survey or cause to be survey'd unto the said *John Peter Sauringer* at the Place aforesaid, according to the Method of Townships appointed, the said Quantity of *500* Acres, if not already survey'd or appropriated, and make Return thereof into the Secretary's Office, in order for further Confirmation; for which this shall be thy sufficient Warrant; which Survey, in case the said *John Peter Sauringer* fulfil the above Agreement within *Six* Months from the Date hereof, shall be valid, otherwise void. GIVEN under my Hand, and the lesser Seal of our Province, at *Philadelphia*, this *24<sup>th</sup>* Day of *July* Anno Dom. 1738.
