Rays Dec^d upper corner on the river bank
Running N. with his Line One Hundred and
Eighty Eight poles to the corner of Rays on
peas Line old line now R. B. Rays line thence
West with his Line ninety six Poles to his
corner Beach Oak crossing a branch thence
North Two hundred and Twelve poles to a
Beach Oak thence West ninety two poles to
a Spruce thence South thirty eight poles to a
Beach Oak at the head of Adams branch
thence down the branch as it meanders to a
White Oak in the Mulberry Island tract
Line now belongs to Alfred Seales thence
East to his corner on his Line being a white
Oak thence South twenty poles on his Line
to a Hickory on the River bank thence across
the said River to the Beginning containing
Three Hundred and ten acres more or
less and I warrant the Title of said
Land to the said Allen and his heirs free
from the claim or claims of Every other

thereof hath contracted Bargained and sold
& confirmed unto the said Henry Strawn
his heirs and assigns a certain tract or
parcel of Land situate lying and being in
the County of Rockingham on the waters of
Wolf Island Creek bounded as
follows (to wit) Beginning at a Red Oak
Right Corner thence north fifteen poles to a
Black Oak John Linder Corner thence west
crossing one branch of Wolf Island Creek twenty
one poles to a white Oak thence north with
