THIS is to certify, That ~~James Philips~~
hath steadfastly done his duty, from the time of
passing an Act at Augusta, to wit, on the 20th of Au-
gust, 1781, until the total Expulsion of the British
from this state; and the said ~~James Philips~~
cannot, to my knowledge or belief, be convicted of
plundering or distressing the country; and is therefore,
under the said Act, entitled to a Bounty of Two Hun-
dred and Fifty Acres of good Land, free from taxes for
ten years.
