1766 I William Wallace of the Colony of Virge
nia and County of Albemarle being weak in body but of perfect Mind & memory
do hereby be to God therefore Calling to mind the Mortality of my Body and
knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die, do make & declare this
my last will and Testament that in any Point whatsoever I shall beque

and recommend my soul into the hands of Almighty God who gave it and my
body I Recommend to the Earth to be Buried in Decent Christian Burial
Touching such worldly Estate wherewith it hath pleased God to Bless me
with in this life I give Dispose & Dispose of in the following Manner
and form, First Let all my Debts be paid

Secondly, I Give and bequeath to son John & to his heirs and assigns forever my tract
of Land Containing two hundred acres lying by the foot of the Blue
Mountain

Thirdly I Give & Bequeath to son Will^m and to his heirs and assigns forever
the upper end of this tract of Land I now live on the line to begin at
a Great Rock and running a cross the River between the two upper
fields and taking about two or three acres on the East side of Sawson's

Fourthly I Give & Bequeath to son Josiah and to his heirs and assigns forever the
end of this plantation I live on and that son William and son Josiah shall
be Equal sharers in paying the Lt. Pleas and tax of this four hundred
acres

Fifthly I Give & Bequeath to son Michael one cow

Sixthly I Give & Bequeath to son John one young black Mare that is named
Own

Seventhly I Give & Bequeath to son W^m one black mare one three year old Mare one
year old Colt which is named his own

Eighthly I Give & Bequeath to Daughter Jean ten Shillings & to her son W^m ten
Shillings all which is due to me from woman law Robt. Dange

Ninthly I Give & Bequeath to Daughter Sarah one young cow

Tenthly I Give & Bequeath to Daughter Ann one young cow

Eleventhly I Give & Bequeath to my Dearly Beloved wife these two bound
Girls Betty & Milliaman Archer to be at her Disposal and also
all & singular my Goods & Chattels & Appurtenances whatsoever to
be to her proper use & at her Disposal. And I do hereby testify
Revoke and Disallow all & every other former Testaments wills Legacies
Bequests & Executors by me in any way before named, without
Benefit therefrom Reserving & Reserving this One Only to be my last
will & Testament in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand
