This Indenture Made this twentieth Day of September in the
 Year of our Sovereign Lord King George the third, and in the year of our Lord Church
 one thousand seven hundred and eighty one **Between** Joseph Rentfro of the
 County of Bedford of the one part, and James Rentfro of the County of Halifax of the other
Witnesseth That the said Joseph Rentfro for and in consideration of the
 Thirty five Pounds Current Money of Virginia to him in hand Paid by the
 said James Rentfro at or before the Enrolling and Delivery of these Presents the
 whereof is hereby acknowledged: he the said Joseph Rentfro hath granted, bargained
 and sold, Aliened, Released, Enjoyed, and Confirmed, and by these Presents doth give
 bargain and sell, Alien Release Enjoyed and Confirm unto the said James Rentfro
 All that Tract piece or parcel of Land situate lying and being in the County
 of Halifax on the South Fork of Black Water River and containing by Estimation
 Nine Hundred and Five Acres of Land, and bounded as followeth to wit
Beginning at great White Oak on the aforesaid Joseph Rentfro's Line
 north Sixty eight and an half Degree West eighty four poles to a white Oak
 south fifty five Degree West two Hundred Poles to a Red Oak thence West
 Hundred thirty seven Poles to a Red Oak thence North twenty eight Degree West
 six Poles to two white Oaks thence North forty Degree West three Hundred
 ten Poles to a white Oak thence south sixty three Degree West ninety eight
 to a white Oak and thence south thirty six Degree East four hundred
 eighty seven Poles to a Red Oak thence crossing Snake Run North eighty
 East one hundred sixty seven Poles to a Red Oak thence south seven by two
 Degree East crossing Fox Run two hundred and eighty Poles to a white
 thence North thirty five Degree East one hundred and twenty poles to a
 Oak thence North seventy five Degree West two Hundred and four poles to
 small white Oak thence north sixty Degree west fifty poles to the Beginning
 being part of a greater Tract of two thousand and three hundred and fifty
 of Land which was conveyed to the said Joseph Rentfro by Richard Randolph
 Gent. by Deed duly Recorded in the County Court of Bedford, and all
 underwoods, Ways, Waters, Watercourses, Profits, Commodities, Advantages, Hereditaments
 and Appurtenances whatsoever to the said Tract, piece or parcel of Land and
 belonging or in any wise appertaining and also the Reversion and
 Remainder and Remainders, Rents and Services of the said Premises and every
 and Parcel thereof and also all the Estate, Right, Title, Interest, Claim
 Demand whatsoever either in Equity or in Law of him the said Joseph Rentfro
 and his Heirs of or to the said Premises or any part or parcel thereof with
 Appurtenances **To have and to hold** the said Tract, piece or parcel
 Land and Premises above mentioned and every part and Parcel thereof with
 Appurtenances unto the said James Rentfro his Heirs and Assigns to the
 Proper use and behoof of him the said James Rentfro his Heirs and Assigns
 forever. And the said Joseph Rentfro for himself and his Heirs and Assigns

do hereby Grant and Agree to and with the said James Rentfro his Heirs and Assigns
 by these Presents in manner and form following, that is to say, that the said Joseph
 Rentfro the said Tract piece or parcel of Land and Premises above mentioned
 and every Part and Parcel thereof with the Appurtenances unto the said James
 Rentfro his Heirs and Assigns against him the said Joseph Rentfro his Heirs
 and all and every other Person and Persons whatsoever shall and Well Warrant and
 forever Defend by these Presents **In witness** whereof the said Joseph Rentfro
 hath to these Presents set his hand and affixed his seal the Day and year above written
 sealed and Delivered In Presence of Joseph Collins

 Privately Examined relinquished her Right of Dower in and to the Land and
 Premises conveyed from the said Joseph Rentfro to the said James Rentfro, All
