I know all men by these Presents that we Robert Hainston, Ambrose Hughes George Hainston Peter Hainston and John Marr of the County of Henry are held and firmly bound unto the Treasurer of the Commonwealth of Virginia for the time being and his Successors in the Penal Sum of Ten Thousand Pounds Spice to which Payment well and Truly to be made to the said Treasurer and his Successors we bind ourselves and Every of us our and Every of our heirs Executors and Administrators Jointly and Severally jointly by these Presents sealed with our seals & Dated this 27th Day of June 1782

The Condition of the above Obligation, is such that if the above bound Robert Hainston, his heirs Executors or Administrators shall well & Truly Collect and pay our Cause to be Collected, and paid, unto the said, Treasurer or his Successors for the time being all Taxes Within the said County of Henry Imposed by an act of Assembly Passed in October Last Entitled an act for ascertaining certain Taxes & Duties and for Establishing a Permanent Revenue then above Obligation, to be Void, or Else remain in full force
