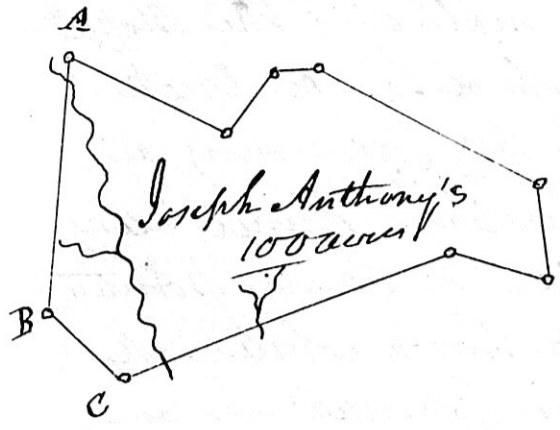

 line. Thence along his own line - S 12 E. 40 poles
 to his Co. pointers on the main Branch. S 73 E. 102 poles to his
 & Reads Co Black Oak. Thence along Reads line. N 83 E. 18 poles
 to his corner small Red Oak N 32 E. 32 poles to his corner Pine
 S 68 E. 76 poles to the first Station

Surveyed for Samuel Hairston 300 Acres of Land situate
 in Bedford County on Branches of Beaver Creek & bounded
 as followeth viz Beginning at Browns & Synches dividing
 Co pointers. Thence along Browns line. S 45 W. 92 poles to his
 Co. Black Oak. S 65 W. 36 poles to his Co Red Oak. Thence off
 S 52 W. 11 poles to a small Red Oak. N 72 W. 102 poles to
 a small Red Oak N 30 W. 78 poles to a Pine. N 10 E. 48
 poles to pointer E - 96 poles to a Pine on the west side
 of Coopers Mountain S - 48 poles to a shrub white Oak
 on a point of Rocks at the South end of the said
 Mountain E - 32 poles to a Pine. N 37 E. 118 poles to
 a Chestnut. N 30 poles to a Black Oak. N 25 E.
 44 poles to a Pine S 70 E. 64 poles to a Pine
 N 30 E. 17 poles to a Pine. N 75 E. 36 poles
 to a Black Oak S 38 E. 130 poles to pointers
 on Synches line Thence along his line
