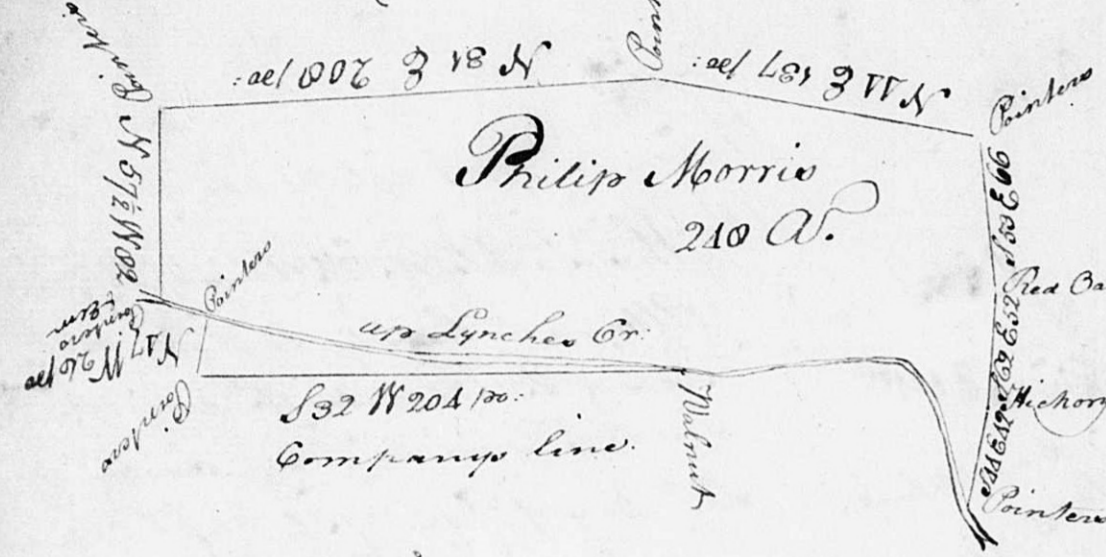


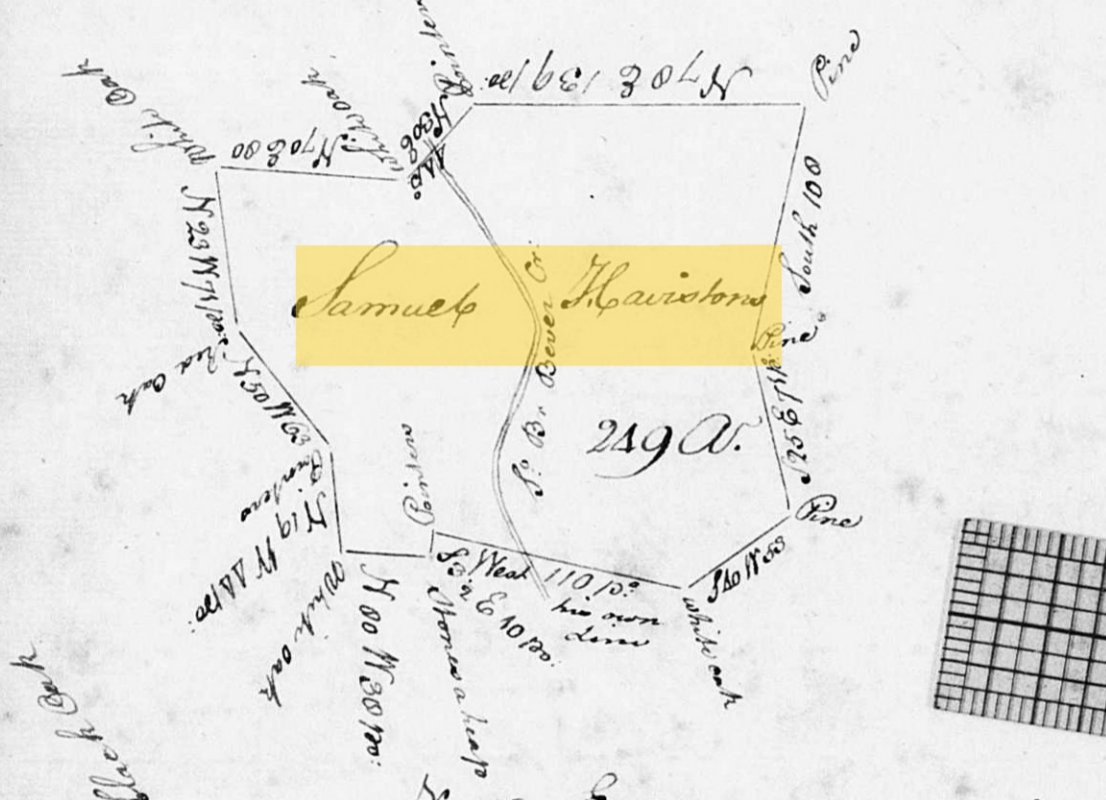
This is a Plot of 341 Acres of Land in

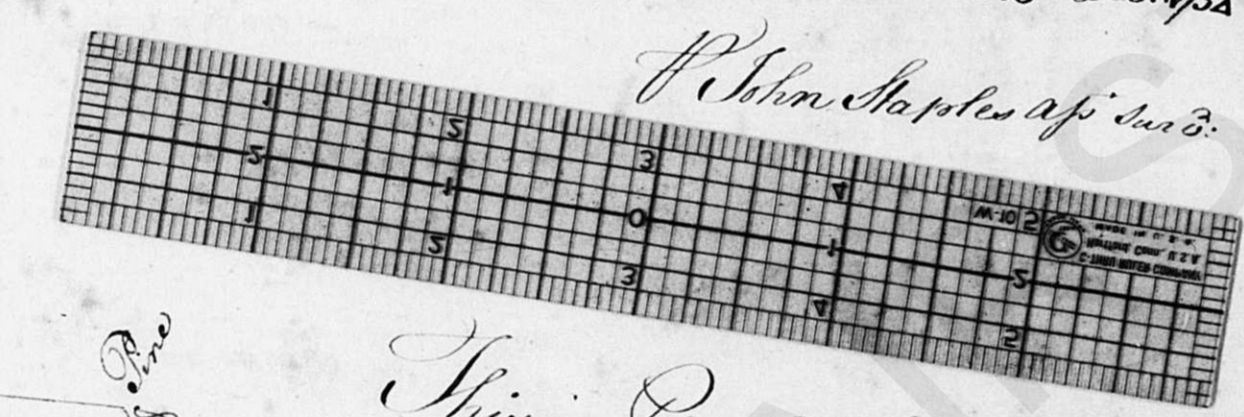
This is a Plot of 210 Acres of Land in

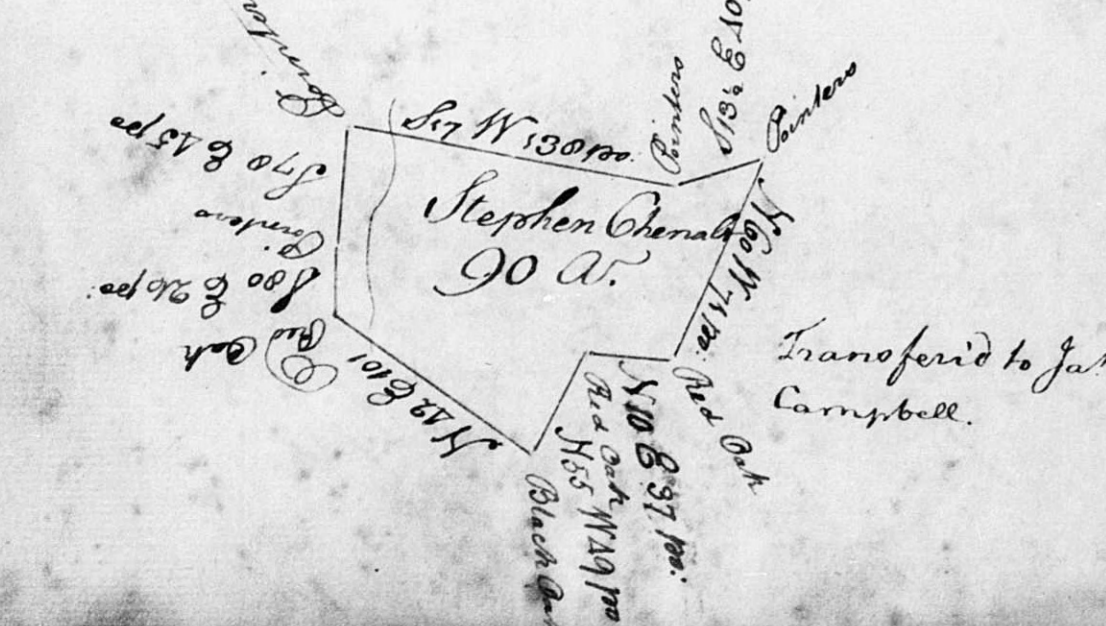
This is a Plot of 249 Acres of Land

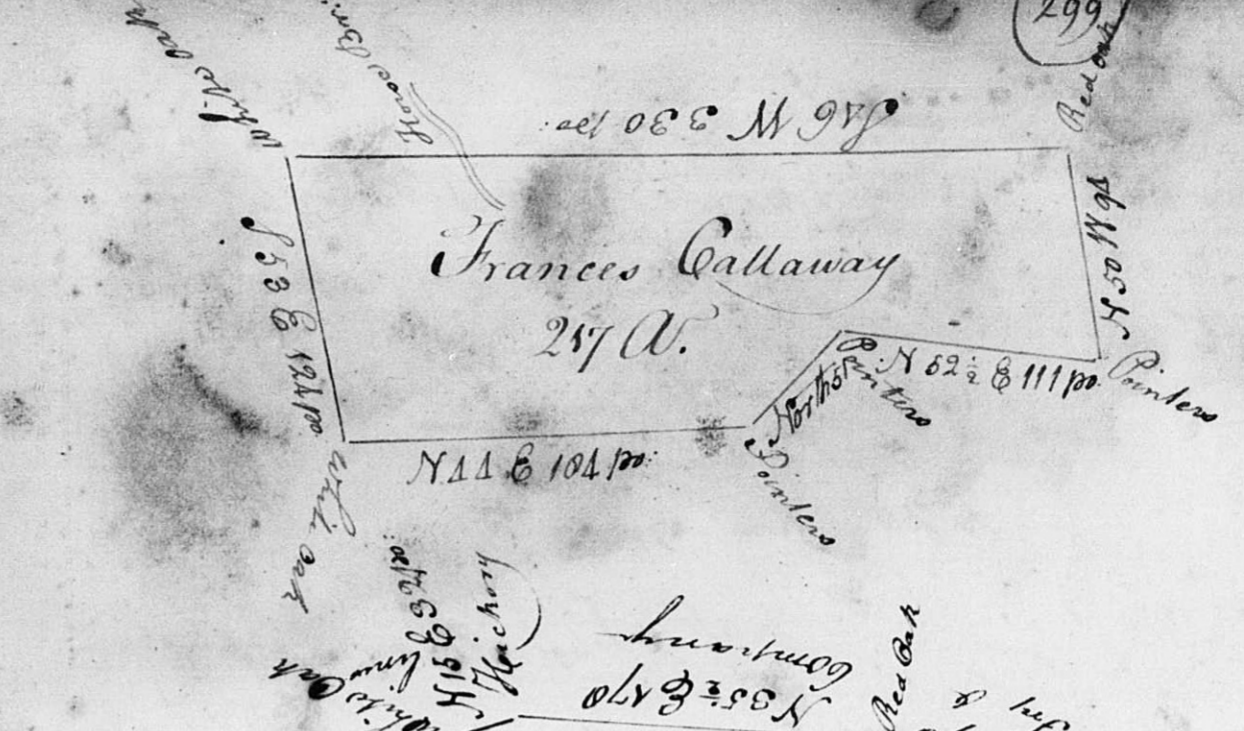
This is a Plot of 249 Acres of Land in

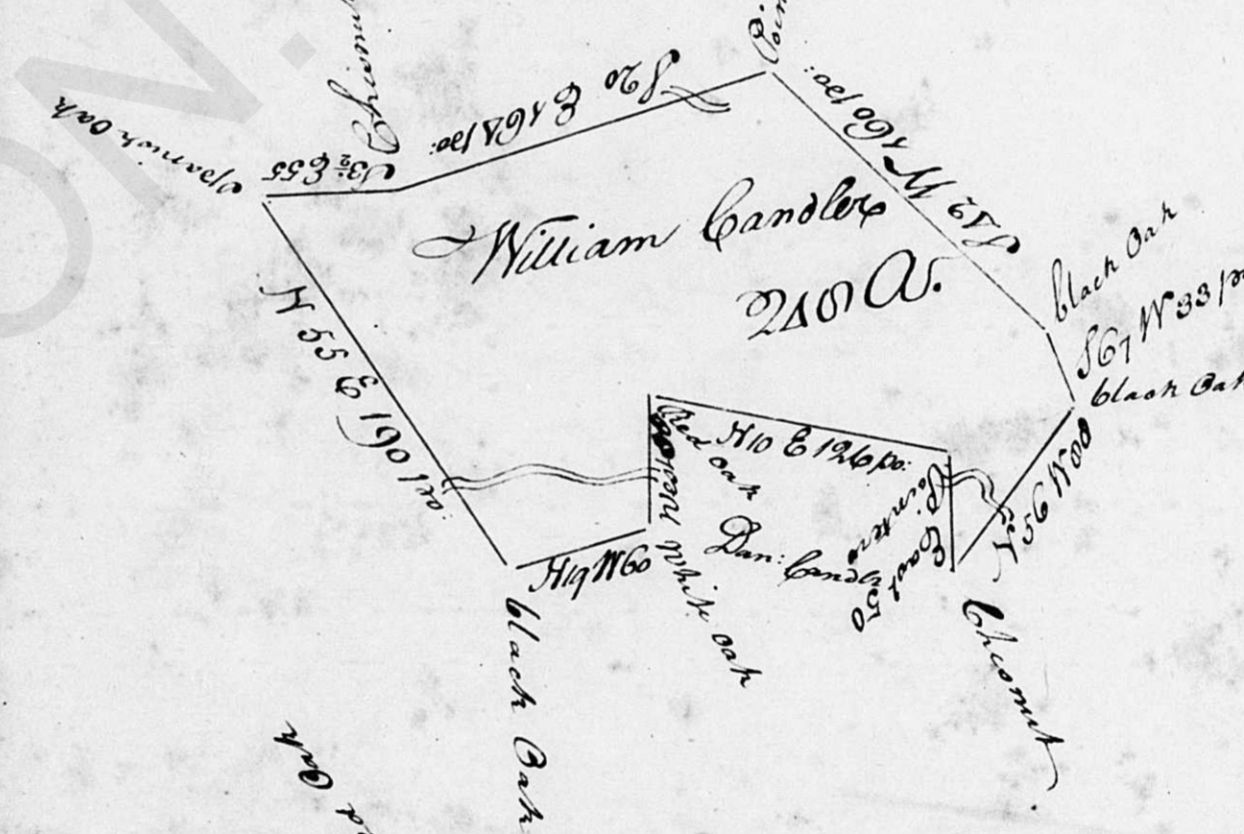
This is a Plot of 247 Acres of Land

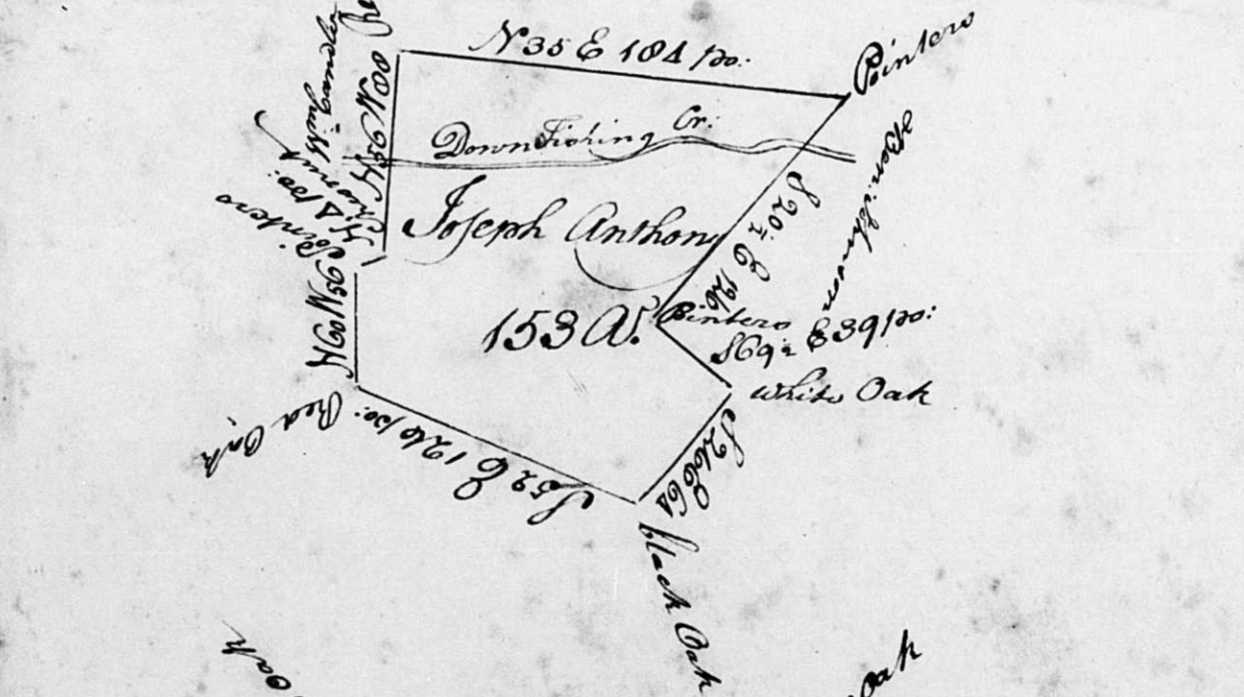
This is a Plot of 256 Acres of Land in

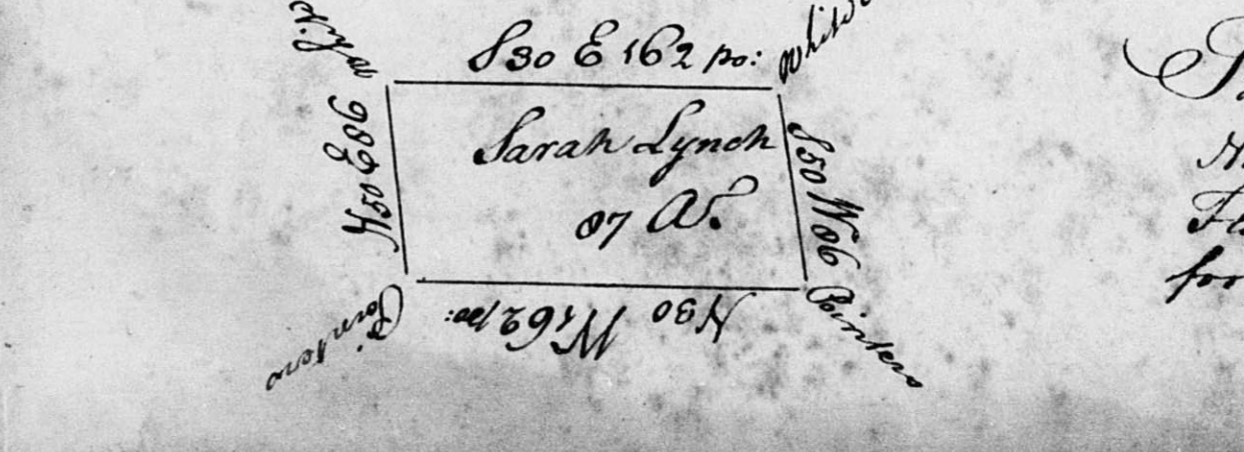
This is a Plot of 210 Acres of Land in
