Know all men by these presents that I Elijah Boon of the County of Allen and State of Kentucky have this day appointed Samuel Hairston of the County and State aforesaid as my lawful attorney in the place of Daniel M Devasher my former attorney and by these presents do nominate ordain and appoint Samuel Hairston as my only true and lawful attorney to transact and trade for me in my helpless situation and collect all moneys and receive the same in my name and receipt for it in my name if needful for all monies that is due to me or may become due to me the above named Elijah Boon as a donation given by the United States of America for my services in the revolutionary service for my support and benefit, and by these presents I have appointed the above named Samuel Hairston as my lawful attorney for the purpose above named until I may think proper to appoint some other person in his room. This Indenture made and entered into this 5<sup>th</sup> day of March 1846 between Elizabeth Storall formerly Elizabeth Williamson Mark Alexander & Nancy Alexander formerly Nancy Williamson Elijah Hairston & Mary Hairston formerly Mary Williamson John Williamson Martha Williamson Thomas Welsh & Lucinda Welsh formerly Lucinda Williamson heirs of James Williamson dec<sup>d</sup>. of the one part & Robert G. Anderson of the other part Witnesseth. That for and in consideration of the sum of one dollar to them in hand paid at and before the executing & delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged doth hereby bargain sell alien and convey unto the said Robert G. Anderson one certain piece or parcel of land being a moiety of a survey of 200 acres surveyed and patented to Edmund Eby being on the waters of Rays fork and said moiety is bounded as followeth to wit being all that part of said 200 acre survey lying on the east side or North side of a spring or branch of Rays fork & including the house where the said Robert G. Anderson now lives & including the improvement between the house & said Branch supposed to contain \_\_\_\_\_ acres for the same more or less to have and to hold the above described moiety or parcel of Land together with all and singular the appurtenances therunto belonging to the only proper use & behoof of him the said Robert G. Anderson & his heirs & assigns forever and the said Elizabeth Storall formerly Elizabeth Williamson Mark Alexander & Nancy Alexander formerly Nancy Williamson Elijah Hairston & Mary Hairston formerly Mary Williamson John Williamson Martha Williamson Thomas Welsh & Lucinda Welsh formerly Lucinda Williamson doth hereby warrant & defend the right & title of the same unto the said Robert G. Anderson and his heirs and assigns forever against the claim or claims of all and every person or persons whatsoever.
