This Indenture made and done this 11th day of September 1832 between Samuel Hartston of the County of Allen and State of Kentucky of the one part and David McQuinn of the County of Barren and State of Kentucky aforesaid of the other part Witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred and fifty Dollars to him in hand paid by the said David McQuinn the receipt whereof him the said Samuel Hartston did give Grant bargain and sell by these presents to him the said McQuinn a certain tract or parcel of land Situate lying and being in the County of Barren and State aforesaid on the waters of Glouster Creek waters of Big Barren River and bounded as follows To wit Beginning on Wilsons poplar corner thence N. 81 N 1/2 poles to a Birch and Black Gum on Caldwell's line thence S. E 160 poles with Caldwell's line to his corner two Hickory and a Poplar thence S 12 N 40 poles to a Birch sugar tree and Poplar thence 19 E 80 Poles to a Red oak and white oak thence N 70 E about 10 Poles to a small Branch cornering on the Branch thence up said Branch with its several meanders to a small Spring which comes in to the N. E side of the Branch which is included thence up the said hollow as before to a marked white oak on or near Wilsons line known as a conditional corner thence with Wilsons line to the Beginning a part of one hundred ^{1/2} acre survey interest in the name of John Anderson and patented in the name of John S. Anderson is supposed to be about sixty five acres more or less which the said Samuel Hartston doth warrant & forever defend
