Before the undersigned a Justice of the Peace in and for said county personally appeared Samuel Harston aged seventy one year's resident in said county who being duly shown deposed and saith that he was well acquainted with Moses Spencer and said Moses Spencer's wife Elizabeth Spencer Late of the State of Tennessee that he was acquainted with the said Moses & Elizabeth in the State of South Carolina several years prior to the time of General Haynes Victory over the Indians in the year seventeen hundred & ninety four (1794) that they were respectable people and lived together as man & wife and were reputed as such - that affiant was married in the State of South Carolina on the 9th day of April in the year eighteen hundred & one (1801) that he has a second of his said marriages - that in the month of November of the year in which he was married he settled in the State of Kentucky near neighbor to the said Moses & Elizabeth Spencer and that the said Moses & Elizabeth's oldest daughter Tabitha was married and had three children born when affiant settled in the state of Kentucky as, aforesaid, whose names were James, Moses & Betty.
