by Nathaniel Hayworth. One Hundred Acre, also Conveyed to him by Joshua
Inman. all of which have been duly recorded in the Register office for
Newberry District reference being thereunto had may more fully appear

and the said Alexander Martin One Hundred and twenty and a half Acre
more or less, Conveyed to him by Benjamin Johnston which has been duly
recorded in the Register office for the District aforesaid, reference being
had may more fully appear And the said Patrick Martin One Hundred
and twenty Acre of Land bequeathed to his wife by her father George Straight
previous to marriage. Fifty Acre of Land Conveyed by Thomas Bauskil to him

One Hundred and four Acre, Conveyed to him by Edward Fink all duly record-
ed in the Register office for Newberry District also twenty eight Acre, granted to him
by his Excellency Paul Hamilton the 17th day of October 1851 also thirty Acre, Conveyed
to him by James Caldwell And the said John Martin two Hundred Acre of Land
Conveyed to him by Edward Fink & duly recorded in the Register office for New-
berry District reference being had may more fully appear

to them that your Honourable House will take their Case into Consideration
and pass an Act confirming their several Title to the above Land in them
