

Will of Robert Percy Hairston, Green County Alabama

In the name of God, Amen; I Robert Percy Hairston of Green County in the State of Alabama do hereby make and declare my last Will & Testament. Item 1. I want all my just debts paid Item 2. I hereby appoint my wife Mary Virginia Hairston as the executrix of this my last Will and testament, and I desire and will that she shall qualify without giving bond, and shall have the power to sell at public or private sale any of the property, real, personal or mixed belonging to my estate.

Item 3. It is my will and wish that she, my said executrix shall get all the property belonging to my said estate together and invest the same to the best advantage, and shall use and expend as far as it is possible to do, the income rents and profits of my estate for the support & maintenance of herself and of any children that may be born to us.

Item 4. Should my said executrix find it necessary to use the Capital or any part of my estate for the maintenance of herself and of four children, she is authorized to do so.

Item 5. When our oldest child shall attain the age of twenty one year, it is my wish that all my estate shall be equally divided between my said wife Mary Virginia Hairston and my child or children that we may have then and then alive And now expressly revoking all other wills and bequests made by me. I have signed this will on this 28th day of July 1899 in the city of Tuscaloosa, Alabama in the presence of each of all of the subscribing witnesses, as certified in the note signed by them in my presence and as stated therein
