 fifteen Between William Alexander of the County of Lunenburg of the One Part and
John Rowland of the County of Cumberland of the Other Part Witnesseth that the said William
 Alexander for and in Consideration of the sum of Ten Pounds Current Money paid to him
 in hand paid by the said John Rowland the Receipt whereof he doth hereby Acknowledge
 and himself to be here with fully satisfied hath given granted Bargained sold alienated
 confirmed and by these presents doth give grant Bargain ^{and Sale} and confirm unto the
 said John Rowland One Certain Tract or parcel of Land Containing two hundred & Sixty Acres
 more or less. Bounded as follows to wit beginning John Gills Pointers Thence on
 Gills Line South forty Sixty degrees East two hundred & Six poles to a black Oak Thence
 on Ashford Hughes Line North Twenty two degrees West Eighty poles to Pointers North
 Thirty Nine Degrees East One hundred & fifty Poles To a black Oak North thirty Two degrees
 West One hundred & Eighty Poles to a corner black Oak Thence on Thomas Gophins Line
 South Sixty four and an half degree west One hundred & Eighty poles to Pointers thence on
 Thomas Carvers South twenty Six degrees East One hundred and ten Poles to the beginning
John Rowland the said two hundred & Sixty Acres of Land with all and singular as
 its Privileges Benefits and Appurtenances unto the said John Rowland his heirs & assigns
 forever and to and for no other use intent whatsoever and the said two hundred & Sixty Acres of
 Land its Appurtenances the said William Alexander for him self and his heirs executors
 Administrators doth and will always Confirm and defend unto the said John Rowland
 his heirs and assigns against all claims and demands from by or under them the said William
Alexander his heirs and assigns or from by or under any other person or persons in any
 manner whatsoever and good full quiet and peaceable Possession of the said Land and all
 and every its Appurtenances the said William Alexander doth hereby Warrant and to the
 said John Rowland and his heirs and assigns will forever by these presents Confirm
 and Defend to John Rowland whereof the said William Alexander hath hereunto set his
 hand and Seal the day above written
