Know ye that for divers good Causes & Considerations but more especially for and in Consideration of the sum of Ten Shillings of good and lawfull money for our use paid to our Receiver Generall of our Revenues in this our Colony and Dominion of Virginia We have given granted and confirmed and by these Presents for us our Heirs and Successors Do give grant and confirm unto Mosias Jones one certain Tract or Parcel of Land containing ninety Acres lying and being in the County of Albemarle on both sides of Moreman's River and bounded as followeth, to wit. Beginning at John M. Cord Sen^r's corner Pointers thence new Lines North forty four Degrees West fifty nine Poles to a Chestnut Oak thence North twenty seven Degrees East forty one Poles to a Hickory thence North fourteen Degrees West sixty three Poles to a Hickory thence South thirty three Degrees West one hundred & forty eight Poles to Pointers thence on Agness M. Cord's Line South forty six and an half Degrees East sixty Poles crossing the River to a Corner thence South ten and an half Degrees East twenty Poles to a Spanish Oak thence new Line South seventy Degrees East eighty two Poles to Pointers on the said John M. Cord's Line thence on his Line North five Degrees West seventy two Poles crossing the River to the Beginning. With all &c. To have hold &c. To be held &c. Yielding and Paying &c. Provided &c.
