 pher Anthony being of the people called Quakers. And
 at a Court held for the said County September the 3^d.
 1789 the same were further proved by Mary Antho-
 ny witngs thereto subscribed & ordered to be recorded
 Ex^o Teste Ro. Alexander C.C.C.

Know all men by these presents that I David Prosser
 of Campbell County for & in consideration of the full and
 just sum of three hundred & fifty six pounds three shillings
 & five pence current money of Virginia due to John
 Forbes of said County I do hereby acknowledge bargain
 & deliver unto the said John Forbes all my Negroes
 which -

Which are as follow vizt. Nally aged seventy years Abb
 aged fifty years Sall aged twenty seven years Napper aged
 twenty four years Bartlett aged twelve years Matt aged
 nine years Bett aged seven years Jenny aged four years
 & Mary aged three months being nine in Number, also
 my four Horses and Stock of Cattle which are eleven in
 number likewise all my household furniture and to
 hold the said bargained premises unto him the said
 John Forbes his Executors Administrators and Assigns
 forever And I the said David Prosser for myself my
 Executors Administrators and Heirs shall and will war-
 rant and for ever defend against all persons by these
 presents the said bargained premises to the said John
 Forbes - Provided that If I the said David Prosser pay
 or cause to be paid to the said John Forbes his Heirs or
 the just sum of one hundred seventy eight pounds one
 shilling and eight pence half penny current money of
 Virginia due by me to the said John Forbes against the
 first day of September next then the said Bill of Sale
 to be void or else to remain in full force and virtue.
 In Witngs whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal
 this tenth day of August One thousand seven hundred
 & eighty nine years -
