Also Lot No 22 called a back Lot situated between the cross Street, and No 4 No 5 and No 23. 2 Acres & 3/4<sup>th</sup> in all 3 Acres and 3/4<sup>th</sup> of an Acre (be the same more or less, the same being part of the Fifty Acres conveyed to the said Trustees by Jeroniah Rust. Together with all the privileges and appurtenances thereunto belonging unto him the said John Folkes. To have and to hold the said Land and premises with their and every of their appurtenances unto him the said John Folkes his Heirs and Assigns forever, and they the Trustees do for themselves and their successors covenant grant and agree to and with him the said John Folkes his Heirs and Assigns, that they the Trustees and their successors, the above granted Land and premises unto him the said John Folkes his Heirs and Assigns shall and will by these presents maintain and forever defend.
