

This Indenture made and entered into this sixth day of July 1838, between Polly Sinsley Widow of William Sinsley Dec^d and Thomas Sinsley, Mariah Holder, John D. Ritchey, Diadamma Ritchey, Polly Sinsley, Elizabeth Sinsley and William Sinsley of the County of Allen and State of Kentucky, of the one part and William Harston of the County of Allen and State of Ky. of the other part Witnesseth, that the said Polly Sinsley and the above named Heirs of William Sinsley Dec^d for and in Consideration of the sum of three hundred and fifty dollars to us in hand paid the receipt by the said William Harston the receipt whereof they doth hereby fully acknowledge, have bargained and sold, and by these presents do bargain and sell unto the said William Harston his heirs and assigns a certain tract of Land containing one hundred Acres, being a part of 200 Acres conveyed by John Foster to William Sinsley lying in the County of Allen on Big Barren River and Bounded as follows, to wit, Beginning at a dogwood and poplar, thence N 54 poles to two Beeches and poplar, Corner to James Brown, thence N 110 poles to two Beeches and Sugar tree on the lake, then South 36 E, 44 poles, 10 E 20 poles, S 20 W 25 poles, S 48 W 50 poles, S 12 W 45 poles to a Maple and Box elder, thence East 134 poles to the beginning, to have and to hold the aforesaid tract or parcel of land with all and singular the appurtenances, therunto belonging or in any wise appertaining, to the only proper use and benefit of the said William Harston and the said Polly Sinsley Widow of William Sinsley Dec^d Thomas Sinsley, Mariah Holder, John D. Ritchey, Diadamma Ritchey, Polly Sinsley, Elizabeth Sinsley, and William Sinsley Heirs of the above named William Sinsley Dec^d doth for themselves, their Heirs jointly doth hereby further Covenant and agree, to and with the said William Harston his heirs Executors or assigns, that they will warrant and forever defend, the aforesaid Land and premises from themselves their Heirs assigns and from the Claim or Claims of all and every person or persons Claiming or to Claim the same In testimony whereof We the said Polly Sinsley Widow of the above Dec^d William Sinsley, Thomas Sinsley, Mariah Holder, John D.
