

Tinsley Polly, his Indenture made and entered into this sixth day of July 1838, between
 Deed Polly Tinsley Widow of William Tinsley Dece^d and Thomas Tinsley, Mariah
 Harston Holder, John D Richey, Diademia Richey, Polly Tinsley, Elizabeth Tinsley
 tract 100 and William Tinsley of the County of Allen and State of Kentucky of the
 same in Barren part and William Harston of the County of Allen and State of Ky
 River entry out of the other part Mississippi, that the said Polly Tinsley and the above
 State, patient named Heirs of William Tinsley Dec^d for and in Consideration of the sum
 Tax paid of three hundred and fifty dollars to us in hand paid the Receipt by the
 Fe 1/12 said William Harston the receipt whereof they doth hereby fully acknowledge
 Deed but ledge, have bargained and sold, and by these presents do bargained and
 w^t J. H. Page bill unto the said William Harston his heirs and assigns a certain
 tract of Land Containing one hundred Acres, being a part of 300 acres
 conveyed by John Foster to William Tinsley lying in the County of Allen
 on Big Barren River and bounded as follows, to wit, Beginning at a
 dogwood and poplar, thence N 15⁴ pds, to two Beeches and poplar, corner to
 Jonas Brown, thence W 110 rods, to two Beeches and Sycamore on the lake, then
 South 36 E, 44 rods, S 10 E 20 rods, S 20 W 25 rods, S 48 W 50 rods, S 12 W 45 rods, to a
 Maple and Box elder, thence East 134 rods to the beginning, to have and to
 hold the aforesaid tract or parcel of land with all and singular the
 appurtenances, thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining, to the
 only proper use and benefit of the said William Harston and the said
 Polly Tinsley Widow of William Tinsley Dec^d Thomas Tinsley, Mariah
 Holder, John D Richey, Diademia Richey, Polly Tinsley, Elizabeth Tinsley
 Dec^d, doth for themselves, their Heirs jointly doth hereby further command
 and agree, to and with the said William Harston his heirs Executors or
 assigns, that they will warrant and forever defend, the aforesaid Land and
 and premises from themselves their Heirs assigns to be and from the
 Claim or Claims of all and every person or persons claiming or to claim
 the same in testimony whereof we the said Polly Tinsley Widow of the
 above Dec^d William Tinsley, Thomas Tinsley, Mariah Holder, John D Richey
 Diademia Richey, Polly Tinsley, Elizabeth Tinsley, William Tinsley, have
 hereunto jointly set our hands and affixed our seals this day and
