

In the name of God Amen I John Robertson of the County of Abbeville and State of South Carolina Being Weak of Body but of sound and disposing mind and Memory blessed be God therefore but calling to mind the uncertainty of life and that it is appointed for all men once to die Do make and ordain this my last Will and Testament in manner and form following that is to say I promise my soul I recommend to God Who gave it and my body I gave to the Earth in sure certain hopes that it shall be raised up by the power of God at the last Day and as touching and concerning such worldly goods as it has pleased God to be stowed on me I give bequeath and Dispose them in the following manner in the first place I Will and Desire that all my Just Debts and funeral Charges be paid and Satisfied Item I give and bequeath to my dearly beloved Wife Jeen Robertson my Negro man named Sam and his Wife Delph and her Child named Arney and Increase of the S^d Wanch and the third part of all my stock & Cash and all my plantation tools and household furniture and the plantation Where on I Now live During her life time and at her Death my Desire is that the whole may be Equally divided between my two Sons William Robertson & Robert Robertson Item I give to my son William Robertson one Negro Wanch named Florod & my Negro man named androw and the wanch's Increase

Item I give and bequeath to my son ~~Robert~~ Robert Robertson my Negro boy named Sam and Negro girl named Nancy and one tract of land containing two hundred acres that I purchased of Joseph Salvador Whean on Bennet Comes formerly lived

Item I give and bequeath to my Son John Robertson twentyfive pounds Sterling to be paid him in Cash out of my Estate

Item I give and bequeath to my eldest son Andrew Robertson one hundred acres of land to be paid to him out of my land and all the remainder of my lands and Estate not already mentioned to be Equally divided between my two Sons William Robertson and Robert Robertson Lastly I make constitute and ordaine my two sons William Robertson & Robert Robertson Executors of this my last Will and Testament and I do hereby revoke disallow and make hereby void all former and other Wills by me made Confirming this for and as my last Will and Testament Sealed with my Seal and Dated this thirtieth Day of May one thousand seven hundred and Eighty Seven and In the Eleventh year of the Independance of the United States of America
