In the name of God Amen I John Robart on Sen. of the County of Abbeville and State of South Carolina being weak of body but of found and difpofing mind and memory Blefsed be God therefore but calling to mind the uncertainty of Lige and that it is appointed for all men once to die do make and ordain this my laft will and Teftament in manner and form following that is to say Imprimis my soul I recommend to God who gave it my body I gave to the earth in sure certain hopes that it fhall be raiped up by the power of God at the laft day and as Touching and concerning such worldly goods as it has pleafed God to beftow on me I give bequeath and difpose them in the following manner in the first place I Will and defise that all my just dwbts and funeral charges be paid and satifyed Item 1 give and bequeath to my dearly beloved wife Jeen Robartfon my Negrow man named Sam and his wife Delph and her child named Amey and increafe of the s. wench and the third part of all my stock & Safh and all my plantation tools and household furniture and the plantation whereon I now live during her lifetime and at her Death my desire is that the whole may be equally divided between my two sons William Robartson and Robert Robartson -- I tem I give to my son William Robertson one megros Wench named Florance and my Negrow man named Androw & the wenchEs increase -- I tem I give and bequeath to my son Robart Robart Son my Negrow boy named Sam and Negrow girl named Nancy and one Tract of Land containing two hundred Gores that I purchased of Joseph Salvador wheareon Bennet Comer formerly lived -- I tem I give and bequeath to my son John Robartfon Twenty-five Pounds Sterling to be paid him in cafh out of my Eftate -- Item I give and bequeath to my Oldest son Andrew Robartfon one hundred acres of Land to be lade of to him out of my Land & all the remainder of my Lands and Eftate not already mentioned to be equally divided between my two sons William Robertson and Robertson Laftly I make conftitute and ordain my Robart two sons William Robertson and/Robertson Executors of this my la will and Teftament and I do hereby revoke difallow and make her by void all former and other wills by me made confirming this
