desire it may be received by all as such First I most humbly bequeath  
my soul to God my maker beseeching his most gracious acceptance of it

redemer Jesus Christ who gave himself to an atonement for my sins  
and is able to save to the uttermost all that come unto God by him

I Give my body to the Earth from whence it was taken in full assurance  
of its Resurrection from thence at the last day as as for my Burial  
I desire it may be done without pomp at the discretion of my wife  
and my Executors hereafter named who I doubt not will manage it  
with all necessary penance As to my worldly Estate I Will and  
positively Order that all my debts be paid

Item I Give to my dear and loving wife Sarah all my real and  
personal Estate during her life any property that she has not use for  
to be sold and made use of for my two Children Charlotte & James  
and at my wife's death to be given to my two Children to Charlotte all  
my personal Estate except one Horse and Negro Boy or follow to James  
and my land to James Should James never be able to take care of  
himself and manage his own business, Charlotte after her mother's  
death is to have my Land and to support James diurnally during his  
life I do hereby constitute and appoint my Brother William Rowland &  
James Kyle Executors of this my Last Will and Testament In Witness  
whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my Seal this fifteenth  
day of April one thousand Eight hundred and fourteen
