

571 } This Indenture made this seventh day of July eighteen hundred and eighteen between John Hutchinson of the State of Georgia and County of Jasper of the one part and Daniel Hearston of the County <sup>and State</sup> aforesaid of the other part Witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sum of two hundred dollars to him in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged having bargained sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said Daniel Hearston all that or parcel of Land containing eighty six and three quarter acres of Land situated in the seventeenth District of formerly Baldwin now Jasper County it being a part of lot No one hundred and twenty five in said district bounded as follows beginning at a post oak and running N 40 East 35.50 to a pine stake thence N 50 East 24.71 1/2 to hickory thence South 40 West 34.25 to a post oak the beginning corner. To have and to hold all and singular the premises and will warrant and forever defend unto him said Daniel Hearston his heirs and assigns to his and their own proper benefit for ever in fee Simple In witness whereof the said John Hearston hath hereunto set his hand and Seal the date first written signed sealed and delivered in presents of

A certain lot of Land containing two hundred two and a half acres be the same more or less lying and being in said State and County aforesaid and in the seventeenth district of then Baldwin now Jasper County known by the Number one hundred and fifty five Drawn and granted to Samuel Jewell beginning on a Red oak Corner running N 45 W. to a pine thence N 45 E to Dogwood thence S 45 E to a hickory thence S 45 W. to the beginning To have and to hold <sup>the</sup> said Lot of Land and all and singular the said premises and appurtenances hereunto belonging or appertaining unto the said Abraham Waldrop his heirs or assigns and I the said Thomas Camp do and will warrant and forever defend the said Lot of Land from me my heirs or assigns or from any right title ~~and~~ Claim of any other person what soever Contending to the said Abraham Waldrop
