Impremis I commit my soul to God hoping that at the Resurrection I shall obtain Mercy thro. the mediatorial Suretyship Righteousness of Christ Jesus and my Body to be Buried at the discretion of My^r: my loving Wife and sole Ex^r: and as to my Worldly Estate I bequeath as follows.

Item I bequeath to my beloved Daughter Hannah Yarbrough the Land and Plantation whereon I now live containing one Hundred Acres to her and her Heirs Lawfully begotten forever after the Death of her Mother.

Item I give and bequeath unto my Daughter Hannah Yarbrough aforesaid all and every Part and Parcel of Personal Estate to her after her Mothers Decease.

That my loving Wife be my sole Ex^r: see this my last Will fulfilled. In Witness whereof I have hereunto set to my Hand and Seal this forth day of March 1749/50
