September and the last day of March next ensuing when such proceffioning shall be made in every precinct and that they do appoint two or more intelligent honest freeholders in every precinct to see such proceffioning performed and to take & return to the said vestry an account of every persons land they shall proceffion and of the persons present at the same and what lands in their precincts they shall fail to proceffion and the particular reasons of such failure

In pursuance to the act of assembly for settling the titles and bounds of lands and for preventing unlawful hunting & ranging the court doth order and direct that the vestry of King William parish ^{that part of} do divide, their said parish, ^{which is in this county,} into so many precincts as to them shall seem most convenient for proceffioning every particular persons land within the same that they do appoint the particular times between the last day of September and the last day of March next ensuing when such proceffioning shall be made in every precinct and that they do appoint two or more intelligent honest freeholders in every precinct to see such proceffioning performed and to take & return to the said vestry an account of every persons land they shall proceffion and of the persons present at the same and what lands in their precincts they shall fail to proceffion and the particular reasons of such failure.

An Indenture of bargain and sale between Thomas Bolling and Agnes his wife of the first part Ann Ames of the second part and Joseph Harrington of the third and last part and the receipt indorsed is acknowledged by the said Thomas and ordered to be recorded.

An Indenture of exchange between Archibald Allen and Elizabeth his wife of the one part and William Norton and Elizabeth his wife of the other part is acknowledged by the said William and ordered to be recorded and the said Elizabeth wife of the said William being first privily examined also acknowledged the same.

The last will and testament of Alexander Hughes deceased is exhibited in court by Powell Hughes and Archibald Hughes the executors therein named and the same is proved by Hannah Saunders and Deiricha Brander two of the witnesses thereto and ordered to be recorded and on the motion of the said executors who made oath according to law certificate is granted them for obtaining a probat thereof in due form giving security whereupon they together with Joseph Mayo their security entered into bond according to law.

Ordered that Joseph Michale Charles Anderson Maria Suspition and John Madden or any three of them being first sworn do appraise in circuit or over the shire if any real and personal estate of Alexander Hughes deceased and return the appraisement to
