hath granted bargained sold aliened enfeoffd and confirmed and by  
these Presents doth grant bargain sell alien enfeoff and confirm  
unto the said William Rowland and his Heirs and Assigns for ever  
One hundred acres of Land, it being part of the Tract of Land  
whereon the s<sup>r</sup> Benjamin Bannon now liveth in the County aforesaid  
and bounded as followeth Vizt Beginning at David Reynolds  
corner Pointes, thence North 40 Degrees West 155 Poles to Pointes
