aforesaid of the other part. Witnesseth that the above named Alexander Joyce for
and in consideration of the sum of Three Hundred & fifty Pounds Current Money
of Virginia to him in hand paid by the said George Hairston the Receipt whereof
he the said Alexander Joyce doth hereby Acknowledge & himself therewith fully
Satisfied Contented & Paid & that by these Presents granted, Bargained, & sold. Alms
Infeoffd. confirmed & Delivd unto the said George Hairston his heirs and assigns forever
all that tract or Parcel of Land Lying and being Situate in the County of Henry & State
of Virginia. on both sides of Marrowbone Creek. Bounded as followeth. Viz. Beginning
at a white Hickory at the mouth of a branch that Emitteth itself into Marrowbone.
