 fully advised of and concerning the premises mentioned &  
 set out in said petition rendered a final decree in said Cause  
 and amongst other things ordered and decreed the sale of  
 said Land and appointed said Swearingen Commissioner  
 to carry said decree into effect, which decree for more certaint  
 ty is hereby referred to, and made part hereof, which Land  
 the Commissioner aforesaid (after advertising the same accord  
 -ing to said decree) sold on the 11<sup>th</sup> day of June 1838 at the  
 Courthouse door in said Allen County, it being <sup>County</sup> Court day  
 to the aforesaid Thomas Harston, for the sum of sixty dollars  
 he being the highest bidder for the same, which Land lies  
 in the County of Barron and State aforesaid on the waters of  
 Big Barron River and bounded as follows, Beginning on a  
 Black and Spanish Oak on Cornups Military line then  
 with said line N 22 W 125 feet to a Poplar and beech, thence

South 60 (N) 30 poles to two beeches and Sugar tree on Shipley's Survey  
 Military line, then South 1 E with said line 253 poles to a Stake  
 then N 38 E 231 poles to the beginning passing Philip's Corner at  
 37 poles containing by survey the aforesaid Number of Acres be  
 the same More or less to have and to hold the aforesaid tract  
 of Land with all and singular its appurtenances, thence to  
 belonging unto the said Thomas Harston and his heirs forever  
 and of the said Swearingen as Commissioner aforesaid for the  
 heirs of said John Whitney deceased, do Covenant and agree
