

This indenture made this 15<sup>th</sup> day of April 1822 between John Whitney of Allen county state of Kentucky of the one party and Chris topher Haynes of the county and state of resid of the other party it is that the said John Whitney for and in consideration of the sum of Eighty dollars to me in hand paid by the said Chris topher Haynes the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, and myself therein fully satisfied have bargained, granted sold and delivered, and by these presents according to due form of law do sell and deliver unto the said Chris topher Haynes a certain tract or parcel of land situate lying and being in Allen county state of Kentucky on the south west side of Big Barren river, Beginning at an ash and beechy corner to a survey of Chris topher Haynes standing on the Bank of <sup>the</sup> river thence down the same with ~~the~~ meanders and with the line of a military survey on the opposite side river N. 14 E 25 poles N 79 E 33 poles at 228 24 poles N 10 W 44 poles N 25 W 24 poles N 34 E 46 poles at 108 48 poles N 4 W 34 poles to a large sycamore lower corner to said Haynes survey then with his line S. 14 W 248 poles to the Beginning with its appurtenances, To have and hold unto the said Chris topher Haynes and his heirs free from the lawful claim of any person or persons what ever, unto him the said Chris topher Haynes to the performance of which I bind myself - his executors &c. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal the date above written.
