

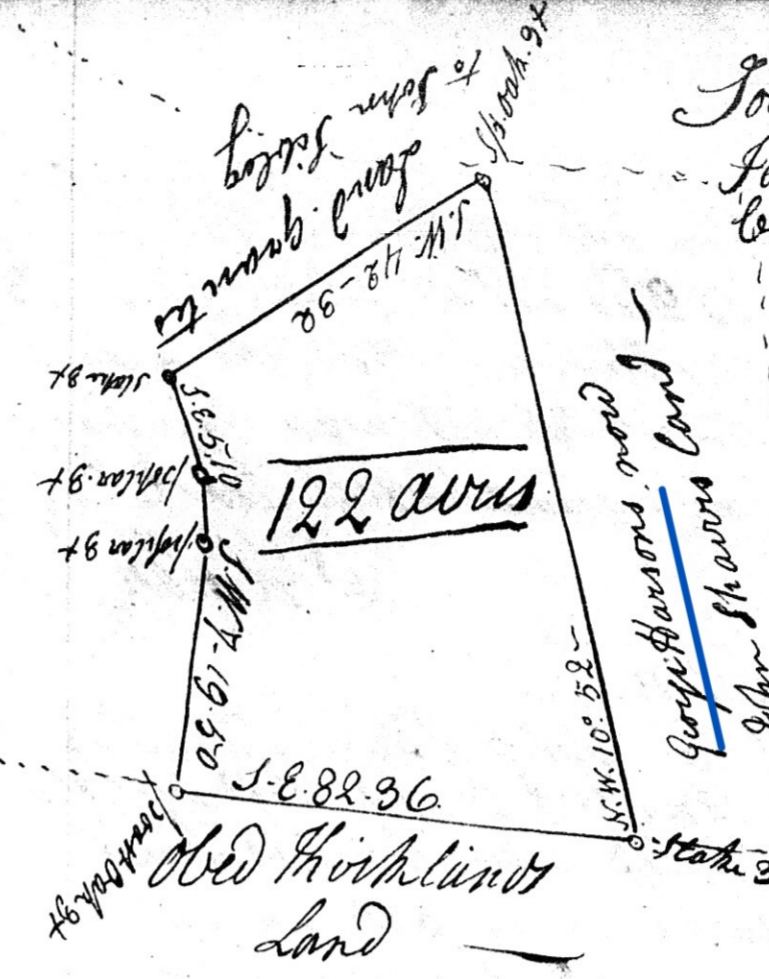

S. and in due form conveyed into the possession of the said George Larson, The said Tract of 122 acres bounding to the west & N.W. on George Larson's land the Complement of said tract east on John Shavars land being also part of said Tract, to the southward on land granted to Obad Kirkland Together with all and singular the rights members and Appurtenances & Hereditaments to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Elias Hendrix his heirs and assigns forever, and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises to the said Elias Hendrix his heirs and assigns, against myself my heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof Witness my hand and seal this twentieth day of July in the year of our Lord 1797 and in the 22^d year of the Independence of the United States of America

The State of South Carolina I Joseph Woodward of Fairfield County in the State aforesaid Gentleman in consideration of ninety two Dollars and ten cents to me paid by James Hendrix of the same County and State aforesaid planter, have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and release unto the said James Hendrix all that Tract or plantation of land containing ninety two acres more or less being part of a Tract of five hundred acres originally granted to major Pierce Butcher twentieth day of January anno Domini 1773, and being at the west side thereof as does appear by a plat of a Survey made by Samuel Alston Esq^r D. S. the twelfth day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety six, bounded to the North by James Nelson's land and to the East by John Woodward's land and to the South by William Strothers land and to the West by said James Hendrix in and - Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said James Hendrix his heirs and assigns forever, and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said James Hendrix his heirs and assigns against myself and my heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof
